DURABILITY

Cotton batting is extremely tough when used as a dense padding layer. The dense web of fibers also prevents premature wear of other comfort layers. The result is a resilient, high quality product that people can rely on for years and years.

COMFORT

Cotton batting's comfort is legendary. As an insulator, it provides a dense, even layer of padding that allows springs to conform to the body while preventing people from feeling the coils. The thermo-physical properties of cotton also help regulate temperature, preventing overheating and ensuring a comfortable sleeping environment.

SAFETY

Cotton batting produced by NCBI member companies is a UL-certified fire retardant filling that meets or exceeds all safety standards

set within the industry. Cotton batting and boric acid are combined to offer a unique smolder- and flame-resistant product.

Like cotton, boric acid is a natural substance that has been used safely for decades to make glass, ceramics, detergents and personal care products like contact lens solutions. Boron, the source of boric acid, is an essential nutrient for plants – including cotton – and part of a healthy diet for people.



ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

Cotton batting is an environmentally sound product, based on both its ingredients and its manufacturing process. Unlike man-made materials, cotton is both renewable and biodegradable.
